Additional sport fish sampling to support policy development (statewide mercury objective) 2. Additional sport fish sampling to support safe eating guideline development 3. Assessing bioaccumulation impacts on aquatic life: possibilities include small fish, bird eggs, etc. 4. Additional sport fish sampling to support policy development (statewide mercury objective) 5. Trend monitoring: sport fish, small fish, bird egg, mussels 6. Special studies (e.g., attempt to discern importance of atmospheric deposition) 7. Piggybacking on the USEPA national lakes survey (24 sites in CA in 2012) In addition, a new idea to consider: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 8.
