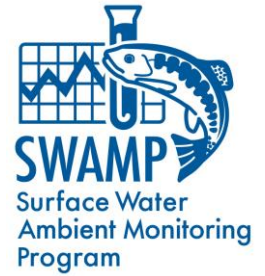

This will begin a second round of sampling of the entire coast, with phases 2 and 3 occurring in 2020 and 2022. 4.	<b>Information: San Diego Bay Fish Consumption Study and Monitoring Plans</b> The San Diego Regional Water Quality Control Board (SDRWQCB), with additional funding from the City of San Diego and the Port of San Diego, conducted a <a href="#">fish consumption survey</a> in San Diego Bay between May 2015 and April 2016. The survey was part of a study that helped the SDRWQCB gather information about the types of fish caught and eaten from the Bay. The SDRWQCB is also developing a fish monitoring plan for San Diego Bay. <b>Desired outcomes:</b> The BOG is aware of the study and its findings, and considers the findings in designing the 2018 Bight sampling.
