		<ul> <li>Develop a smaller Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) to discuss and make decisions about highly technical components of the dashboard (e.g. data and metric weighting options and recommendations).</li> </ul>

<u>Purpose:</u> Discuss common research and data gaps the HWP would like help addressing.

<u>Background:</u> The gaps that are discussed will be posted on the <u>HWP Research and Data Gaps webpage</u> so that parties interested in undertaking new research can be informed of what the HWP thinks is needed.

#### Notes:

- Research Gaps Discussed:
  - Relating environmental conditions to stressors; need more refined understanding of condition-stress relationships.
  - Evaluation of the vulnerability of Category 1 water bodies to stressors, especially at larger spatial scales.
  - Evaluation of the effectiveness of bond funded projects in improving watershed/environmental/system health.
  - Understanding of how past fires impact watershed/environmental/system health.
    - Potentially useful datasets:
      - US Forest Service Timberlands data
      - Cal Fire datasets that display areas targeted for fuels reduction
  - More refined understanding of surface water and groundwater relationships.
    - Potentially useful datasets:
      - The Nature Conservancy's Freshwater Species database, groundwater dependent ecosystems layer
  - Knowledge gaps discussed during the 2nd Statewide Forest Meeting in early Feb.
