- ► AB1946 Chapter 152 (Wayne, 1999-2000): Public Beaches: survey
- ► AB 1876 (Chan) in 2004- Bay Beach Monitoring Bill
- ► AB538 (Wayne, 1999-2000): Public Beaches: bacteriological standards

### Background of the First NorCal BWQW

- First meeting occurred in early 2005
- Started as an offshoot to the Southern BWQW
- Group to discuss new and proposed legislation and how it would affect various sectors of the beach community including the public, dischargers, regulators, and stakeholders
- ▶ 2010- first attempt to bring the BWQWs under the Water Quality Monitoring Council "umbrella"
